## WHAT THE TOWN COUNCIL IS DOING...

- The town council is currently collating a town wide response to the COVID-19 response identify spontaneous volunteer groups that are forming around the Town and building a database of contacts to assist with spotting duplications and mistakes.
- The Community Emergency Volunteers have been trained in basic Public Health response although they do not at this stage have PPE.
- We are putting an emergency management structure in place in order to be able to receive requests from yourselves and get these actions / instructions out to volunteers in the town to assist

## WHAT THE COMMUNITY EMERGENCY VOLUNTEERS CAN DO TO SUPPORT YOU...

- The CEVs have their own 4x4 double cab pick up truck with high visible markings with any driver insurance. This allows us to provide transport for medication, shopping or other urgent deliveries across the Bradford on Avon area board.
- CEVs are equipped with branded Hi-Viz bibs and also have access to Hi-Viz jackets and trousers allowing them to guard cordons or road closures if necessary.
- As well as Public Health Training CEVs have been given Community Resilience training in order to understand the principles of how the emergency services work such as Gold/Silver/Bronze command. We are therefore well placed to work with the emergency services during a response and act as eyes and ears as well as additional boots on the ground.
